APPROXIMATE COSTS

Seeds of Hope has a true range in costs because the overall costs will be heavily affected by the donation that your company makes to the selected organization. We recommend a minimum donation of \$10,000 to truly make an impact at an organization. In addition to the monetary donation that your company provides, there will be a minimum cost of \$5,000 for video production and project management, with costs normally ranging from \$8,000 - \$25,000 based on the organization or project selected.
